The main banjo riff is below.

To accomodate the sound of standard 4-string banjo tuning (C,G,B,D) for guitar it is necessary to detune the high E string down a tone to a D (giving us E,A,D,G,B,D)

*PEDANT'S NOTE* there's no real need to drop the D to a C for this tune, but you could for the true banjo tuning.
